## NOTIFICATION

The 11th November, 2005.

**No. FTX.181/2004/PV57 :—** Whereas it is expedient to streamline the functioning of the Check-gates operated by different departments of the State, namely, Departments of Excise, Forest, Transport, and Taxation of the Government of Assam at Srirampur in Kokrajhar District in the State of Assam.

And whereas it has been found expedient to ensure speedy clearance of transactions in respect of transport vehicles entering and exiting the State, the Governor of Assam is hereby pleased to constitute a Composite Check gate at Srirampur in Kokrajhar District in the State of Assam by amalgamation of (1) *State Excise Check gate*, (2) *State Forest Check gate*, (3) *State Transport Check gate* and (4) *State Taxation Check gate*, operating in the aforesaid place for the purpose of checking of transport vehicles as per the provisions of Acts and Rules pertaining to and administered by the respective departments stated above.

The procedures to be followed by the aforesaid departments of the State at the Composite Check gate will be as under:

1. The Composite Check gate will provide for a single window clearance for the traffic involved in inter-State trade.
2. The concerned departments will check the relevant documents for the purposes of their respective Acts as follows :

(a) **Excise Department :**

They will check whether any excisable commodities are being transported and if so, whether relevant documents accompany the goods vehicle in compliance with the Excise Laws.

(b) **Forest Department :**

This Department will check the relevant documents accompanying the transport vehicle as required by relevant Forest laws of the State in respect of the forest products.

(c) **Transport Department :**

This Department will check the weight of the vehicle, registration of the vehicle and other relevant documents accompanying the transport vehicle as required under Motor Vehicles Act and the Rules framed thereunder and impose the required fines etc. as per provision of Motor Vehicle Act and Rules framed thereunder and Notification issued from time to time in this regard and realisation of APGT and different Taxes.

(d) **Taxation Department :**

This department will ensure proper record of goods entering and leaving the State to curb the evasion of tax under various Taxation Acts.

3. The Taxation Department shall act as the Nodal Authority in respect of the Composite Check gate and the in-charge of the Taxation Check gate will act as the co-coordinator of all other Check gates covered by the Composite Check gate.
4. The various departments mentioned here-in-above will check the documents at the respective designated counter within the Composite Check gate and the final clearance for the vehicle to cross into or out of Assam will be given by the Taxation department.
5. A Composite Check gate will ensure clearance of any vehicle within a period of 12 hours, in case the documents are in order.
6. In case a vehicle is detained for more than 12 hours from the time of receipt of the original documents, the vehicle registration number along with the reasons for detention will have to be maintained in a specific Detention register with remarks and certification by the concerned department and by the cocoordinator.
7. Finance (Taxation) Department will be the nodal department for the Composite Check gate at Srirampur and Boxirhat.
8. A senior IAS/ ACS officer not below the rank of Additional Secretary to the State Government will be posted as "Composite Check Gate Officer" for administration of the Composite Check Gate and he will report to the Finance (Taxation) Department.

This notification will come into force with immediate effect.
