Sub : Payment of taxes through State Bank of India Branches.

At present State Bank of India (SBI) is providing the facility to dealers to pay their taxes online through internet enabled accounts with SBI. Due to some reasons some individuals/corporates do not want to use their accounts for online payment of taxes. Further, many dealers do not have internet enabled accounts or have accounts in Banks which do not have e-payment facility. In order to cater above type of customers, SBI has introduced "Third Party e-Tax; online payment of taxes by SBI/non SBI dealers through Branch Office Accounts." Now dealers can pay taxes at SBI branches and the branch in turn will pay the same online through an office account. For the said purpose, the dealer is required to fill in the appropriate physical challan form related to the particular taxes along with cheque (local clearing only) at the designated branch. In case of payment in cash, the same shall have to be tendered at cash counter at the designated branch. However, it is informed by SBI that outstation cheques would not be accepted as these might cause delays, resulting in inconvenience to the dealer. Tax amount can also be tendered through RTGS/NEFT also. Cyber receipts will be delivered by SBI to the dealers over the counter/by e-mail as requested by the dealer.
