NOTIFICATION

The 4th November, 2013

NO.FTX.181/2003/159: In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 6 of the Assam Entry Tax Act, 2008 (Assam Act, XII of 2008) the Governor of Assam having considered it necessary in the public interest so to do, hereby exempts the organization of the State Government shown in column (1) of the Table below from the liability to pay entry tax in respect of specified goods mentioned in column (2) subject to the restrictions and conditions specified in column (3) of the said table :-

| Criminal Investigation Department (CID), Govt. of Assam, Ulubari, Guwahati | Computer hardware & peripherals, servers, V-SAT and other specified goods relating to Crime & Criminal Tracking Network System (CCTNS) | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The goods imported are exclusive property of the organization as specified in column (1). The organisation is permitted to import the class of goods as specified in column (2) to the extent of Rs.17,98,65,619/- only for CCTNS Project funded by the Govt. of India. Road Permits (Form-62) shall be issued to the organisation for import of class of goods as specified in column (2) and utilization of which, is to be submitted by the organisation within one month from the date of the receipt of the goods or at the time of application for issuance of fresh Road Permit, whichever is earlier. |

The notification shall be deemed to have come into force on and from 1st

December, 2012.
